- Heard from Serpentine Jarrahdale as they shared their Social Enterprise story and took questions from the group

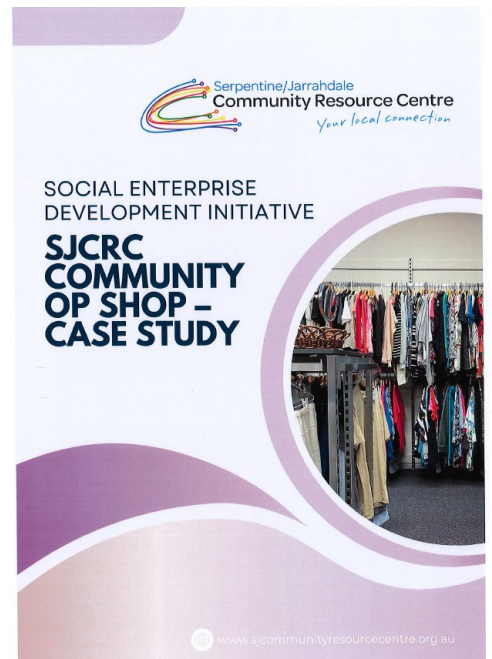




Serpentine Jarrahdale CRC have seen significant changes in their local community, leading to growing demand from community without increase in core government contract funding. SJCRC needed sustainable, self generated income that aligned with its mission, empowered community and that could evolve over times.

A Community Op Shop generates income and reinforces values of affordability, sustainability and local connection at every level of it's operation.
